**Admission to class XI, 2019-20
(for students from outside schools)**

1. Only few selected students from other schools passing the Secondary Level Examination from WBBSE /CBSE / ICSE in the year 2018 may be admitted to the Science Stream after an Aptitude Test.
Medium of Instruction: English. Subjects offered: Bengali / Hindi, English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology / Statistics.
2. Students willing to apply must secure at least 285 marks out of 300 in the Science Group and 150 marks out of 200 in the Language Group.
Students, having faith in the objectives of the Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission, physically fit and mentally prepared to stay in this Residential School and have the inclination towards living and studying on their own, may apply.
3. A written Aptitude Test in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics will be held within a week or so from the date of publication of Madhyamik Results. The Written Test will be of 3 (three) hours duration (one hour each for each subject) and will carry 50 marks each in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.
Students should have a good knowledge of the basic concepts and fundamentals of the subjects taught in the Secondary Level. A brief outline of the syllabus is given over leaf.
4. ONLINE: Application form and Prospectus for admission to class XI (2019-20) will be available only for download (please use 75 GSM A4 size white paper) from our website for four days (excluding Sundays and holidays) from the day of publication of results of the Madhyamik Pariksha, 2019.
The filled application form along with all necessary documents and Rs. 600.00 (Rupees six hundred only) (Cash) should be submitted by hand in our school office between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on all working days within two days from the last date of issue of application forms.
Application forms send through post / courier won't be accepted. Candidates are required to collect the Admit-Card of the Aptitude Test at the time of submission of the Application Form.
5. Documents to be submitted along with the application form:
 - i) SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if applicable;
 - ii) Self-attested photocopy of the Registration Certificate, Admit Card, Mark Sheet and Pass Certificate of the Secondary Examination;
 - iii) Certificates regarding co-curricular activities, if any.
 - iv) Original Mark Sheet, Registration Certificate and Admit Card to be shown at the time of application form submission.
 - v) Aadhaar Card.
6. List of selected students will be published within a week of the Aptitude Test.
7. Fees & Charges:
Rs. 4,000/- per month and annual charges of Rs. 10,500/-. Additional fees for tutorial classes are applicable. Details of fees and charges can be had from the School office or from our website.
8. Special tutorial classes, mock tests etc are arranged by the Vidyalaya to prepare our students for various competitive examinations. No permission to take tuitions or for attending mock tests outside the school campus is given.
9. All the students are expected to wear dresses supplied by the Vidyalaya in Bhavanas also.
10. Financial concession may be given to a few deserving students only.

Sub: Admission to class XI, 2019-20 (for our students)

Dear Sir / Madam,

Perhaps you are aware that the admission to the Higher Secondary course of this Vidyalaya is restricted to the Science Stream (with Physics, Chemistry Mathematics, Biology / Statistics) only and that too with a limited number of students. So, all the students reading in Class X will not automatically get the chance for the continuation of their studies in the Higher Secondary Course here. Observing all other formalities, selection of students will be made on the basis of their academic results in all subjects of classes IX & X and Madhyamik Pariksha as well as their overall performance in the Vidyalaya and its hostels during their stay here.

We are giving below some important information in this regard:

1. Only limited number of students for the Science Stream will be admitted.
2. Students securing a minimum of 85 percent marks in aggregate or at least 90 percent marks in the Science Group and at least 70% in English and Bengali / Hindi / are eligible to apply.
3. Medium of instruction: English

Subjects offered: Bengali/Hindi, English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology/Statistics

4. Application Forms will be available at Rs. 600/- only for 2 days (excluding Sundays and holidays) in the School Office between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. from the day of distribution of Marksheets of the Madhyamik Pariksha.

Duly filled in forms are to be submitted within 2 days from the last date of issue of the Application Forms.

5. A list of selected candidates (on the basis of marks obtained in classes IX and result of Madhyamik Pariksha 2019) will be published after the publication of Madhyamik result.
6. **Those not selected may appear at the Admission Test to be held at a suitable date (to be announced later) after the publication of Madhyamik result. One has to adhere to the criteria to fill up the Form for the said Admission Test.**
7. List of selected students will be published within a week or so.
8. Documents to be submitted along with the application form:
 - i) SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if applicable
 - ii) Photocopies of the Registration Certificate, Admit Card and Mark Sheet of Madhyamik Pariksha
 - iii) Aadhaar Card

9. Fees & Charges:

Rs. 4,000/- per month and annual charges of Rs. 10,500/-.

Additional fees for tutorial classes are applicable.

Details of fees and charges can be had from the School office or from our website.

10. Special tutorial classes, mock tests etc. are arranged by the Vidyalaya to prepare our students for various competitive examinations. No permission is given to take tuitions or for attending mock tests outside the school campus.
11. Financial concession may be given to a few deserving students only.
12. All the students are expected to wear dresses supplied by the Vidyalaya authorities in the Bhavanas also.
