1) School Recognition:



 Our Vidyalaya was bestowed for Academic Excellence of AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE by the INSTITUTE OF LEADERSHIP ENTREPRENEURSHIP.

26 November 2024, the Award was handed over to us at a programme. A trophy along with a certificate of appreciation was accorded to us.



20 students of our school have been selected for the JBNSTS Junior Talent Search Test – 2024, Scholarship Award and 6 students for the JBNSTS Junior Talent Search Test – 2024, Encouragement Award. Also our Vidyalaya received JBNSTS BEST SCHOOL AWARD on 25th January 2025 at Auditoriam Hall of Presidency University.

2) Admission Test:

- a) The Admission Test for class V was held on Sunday, 3rd December, 2024 at Narendrapur, Siliguri and Manipur centres. This year, 2592 boys appeared.
- b) The Admission Test for class VI was held on Sunday, 22nd December, 2024. Total 526 boys appeared in the exam.
- c) The Admission Test for class VII was held on Sunday, 23rd December, 2024. Total 119 boys appeared in the exam.

d) The Admission Test for class XI (Science Stream) was held on Saturday, 8th March, 2025. Total 863 boys appeared in the exam. 65 boys were selected for the viva test and 42 students were selected for the Admission to class XI.




