



## Report for the period from March 21, 2025 to July 10, 2025

### 1) School Recognition:

- a) We are pleased to inform that Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Narendrapur has been officially certified as an Eat Right School by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

This certification is recognition of our commitment to promoting safe, healthy and sustainable eating habits among students. It is valid for the period from 25 November 2024 to 24 November 2026.

### 2) Performance in the Secondary & Higher Secondary Examinations:

The performance of our students in the school final examinations has always been brilliant. Every year more than one hundred boys appear at the Madhyamik Pariksha and achieve hundred percent success. Many times, our students secured top ranks in the state merit list. In the past, it so happened that the top-most rank was secured by our students for four consecutive years. **This year in the Madhyamik Examination, 121 out of 123 students secured 85% and above marks; while all students got 80% and above marks.**

- This year in the Higher Secondary Examination, 90 out of 123 students secured 90% and above marks; while 122 students got 80% and above marks. Ten students of our school came within top 10 ranks in the state (after PPS).

b) Results of JEE Advanced:

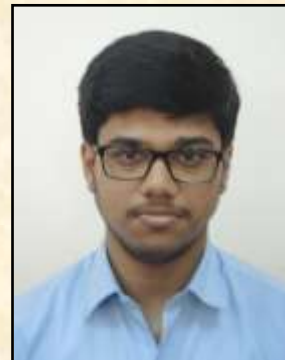
This year 9 students from our Vidyalaya have secured prestigious ranks.
